



IS YOUR CHILD HAVING DIFFICULTY IN SPEECH AND LANGUAGE AREAS?

CHILDREN FROM 2 TO 3 YEARS:

- 1. He (She) communicates mostly through gestures, noises and cries.
- 2. Does not communicate with phrases from 2 or 3 words or short sentences.
- 3. When speaking, most people do not understand him or her.
- 4. Does not follow instructions of 2 simple steps without repetition and without gestures that helps.
- 5. Does not play properly and purposeful with their toys. He (she) can not use the imagination and create stories or events with their toys.
- 6. Does not like to play or wants to play with other children.
- 7. Does not look at the face of the speaker, will not smile or mimic facial expressions of others.
- 8. He (She) does not answer or makes simple questions (what, who, where).
- 9. Does not understand or use a variety of basic vocabulary (body parts, animals, food, everyday objects, toys, clothing).
- 10. Eats very little choices of food and puts everything in their mouths, or can not tolerate when others thoch his (her) mouth.

CHILDREN FROM 4 TO 5 YEARS:

- 1. Does not communicate in complete and correct sentences in a proper order and with all conjugated elements regarding gender, number, person, time and manner. Use single words phrases, and incorrect sentences.
- 2. You can not understand everything they say, it is still necessary to tell people he (she) does not know, what they mean.
- 3. Does not follow multiple instructions without repetition or complex instructions with minimum repetition. Requires constant repetition.
- 4. Does not formulate reasoning questions like “why” and “how” .

- ___ 5. Can not understand or answer questions from a story that was read to him (her).
- ___ 6. Their vocabulary development is very limited.
- ___ 7. Difficulty to narrate events such as movies or what happened at school.
- ___ 8. Their attention is very limited.
- ___ 9. No interest shown in numbers or letters.
- ___ 10. Have difficulty socializing, they treat strangers as if they were family. Does not have friends at school because they prefer to play alone.

CHILDREN 6 YEARS AND OLDER:

- ___ 1. Their speech is not entirely clear. They can not pronounce the letter "r" or other Spanish sounds
- ___ 2. Fails to reads fluently, read syllable by syllable, they confuse letters.
- ___ 3. They can not stay focused on an activity for long.
- ___ 4. Difficulty following multi-step or complex instructions without repeating them. He (She) constantly is requesting that you repeat things.
- ___ 5. Difficulty concentrating and understanding, which worsens with certain noises in the surrounding.
- ___ 6. No friends and their social behavior is not appropriate.
- ___ 7. Difficulty understanding verbal language (facial expressions) and can not communicate nonverbal language (gestures).
- ___ 8. Does not discriminate the sounds within a word or tonic syllable within a word.
- ___ 9. Can not read short stories and answer simple questions in reading comprehension.
- ___ 10. Difficulty with writing, can not write sentences, reverse letters, changes letters or leaves spaces between words.



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
